Ron invited us to submit pictures and stories to add to the website, and then reported on the illegal netting that took place in late April. There was some confusion by the DNR. The DNR did talk to the tribal council and they will stop any netting on our lake.

The DNR took net samples and reports that the walleye and northern are doing well, the bass population is good and the pan fish are small.

We are paying to have a counter with a time stamp at the public landing.

Chuck will do testing for zebra mussel and send the samples to the county.

Bruce reported that the LID annual meeting will be July 18, 2015. Bruce said he was stepping down from the LID board. He was presented with a lake association jacket and thanked for all his work. Bruce will help with the reapplication for LID. The attendance for the LID annual meeting has been low so we are having the meeting the same day the association has its social at Char's.

Bruce outlined the major assignments for LID and who was lead on making sure of a timely completion.

Randy is working on the signs and looking for help with boat inspections.

The meeting was adjourned.
